Dear Friends,

I have attempted to get this letter to you 6 times now but never managed to finish it so I am going to sit here until it is sent. There is much to celebrate this month. The first being that yesterday was Easter and we remembered the great sacrifice that our Lrd made in order that we might know Him and have freedom in Him and look forward to eternal life with Him. Prse His name, for He is indeed the Risen Lrd! Last night the Ch gave wristbands out to all who attended, I love this multicultural photo of the Wship team. It is a picture of H-ven, every tribe, tongue and nation.



As many of you know John returned to England to help his family after the sudden death of his father. We really appreciated all your prs throughout this flying visit. I was grateful to be able to join John for 10 days for the funeral, which meant we were both able to help sort through the family home and tidy it ready for selling. Although it was obviously an emotional time, we were so thankful we could support John's sister and brother through this. Please continue to remember John's sister, Sue, as she tries to finalise everything.

Thank you also for remembering Aunty Miriam, whom many of you know. She looked really well when we saw her last month but obviously getting older is no fun so please continue to remember her and her health. John and I visited my parents which again was an unexpected blessing and we truly valued this time we could spend with them.



It was wonderful to be in Plymouth for the 50th celebration of our home Ch, Plymstock Chapel. John and I and my parents all enjoyed a lovely evening of meeting with our Plymstock family over a bring and share supper, a lovely celebratory service and an extremely difficult local quiz! (Peter Taylor wasn't much help to us!!) We pr continued increase of members at

Plymstock.

I had one day in NN before going up north of China, to QingDao, to teach. Caryn and I taught a Cxn Wholeness Framework training for 3 days and then held a 3 day Sandtray training for some local C counsellors. It was an extremely encouraging trip and we were very blsd. Two women came to





know Him during the CWF training and many came back to Him throughout the Sandtray training. It was such a privilege to be there.

From QingDao Caryn travelled home to care for Xiao Bo and I continued on to run another training in ZhengZhou. This was a larger training and went really smoothly. I was thankful to be able to serve my old classmates, Bercy, Ruth and Julia, all local counsellors who are doing amazing work in reaching the broken hearted for Him.

Next travel was to Hong Kong to celebrate the wedding of Irene and Sonic, old EMA volunteers. It was a beautiful wedding in true Irene quirky style! On Good Friday evening, we had an EMA get together with over 30 HK volunteers and their children. It was so special to have Wship and communion with the volunteers, to look back on his goodness

over the past years and to pr together re the future direction. For me it was an honour to be with friends that used to call me older sister, then aunty and now to have their children call me grandmother, such an honour, His legacy.



While we were in UK the local team that we had trained here ran the village camp and it went very well. In fact, tomorrow we have a meeting with the leaders to see how we can be further involved and maybe run a summer camp for them. The village is only about an hour from the city, but is very poor and mainly old people and children, as many villages are now. The parents are often away working in factories and only manage to get home once a year at Chinese New Year.

John and another brother have started a Dis Training study at the local Ch we attend. They have 15 students who all have daily homework and meet once a week to discuss the passages studied. Please remember John and the brother as they head up this study. Ben and Rachel are students on the course, it is good to see them becoming even more B-cally aware.

Ben and Rachel and 8 other MK's from our area recently returned from a youth camp in another province. They all returned home very pumped about Him! Please pr for the MK's here that they would continue to be pumped knowing Him.

Other Prse points:

Many of you will remember the family we helped with 2 deaf boys, who were able to receive hearing aids and attend school. The mother recently wrote with such thankfulness for Gd's continued provision. The boys are allowed to stay at the school, even though officially the older one should move to "big" school. She continues to turn to Gd for her strength and source of peace. Prse Gd! The whole family are now reading the Good Book and slowly learning more of Him and His ways. We hope to make a trip up to visit them all the week of the 16th April.

We have also just heard that another NGO has opened a support school for children with cerebral palsy closer to Joy and Rita's home. So, we are also planning a village trip to see if we can get their mother to allow them to attend this special school. Previously she was very resistant but now the school has moved closer we Pr she will be willing.

Please remember Doreen as she attends the Living Wholeness Training Programme for 5 weeks. This unit is more focused on increasing her listening skills and learning about mental health. Doreen is enjoying the course but as a Cantonese speaker struggles with the languages of English and Mandarin for her studies. Please Pr for her that she will understand and be able to apply what she is learning.

Hua has been busy sewing portable Sandtrays that John designed and we are now selling after the trainings. She is doing a great job. She continues to meet with other Deaf in the area and share Him with them.

Due to returning to England for Dad's funeral we put looking for a new Mishkan (EMA China base) on hold. But we are now starting to look again and would value pr for finding the perfect place to rent as a centre for trainings and counselling and for Sptl retreats for those that are serving fulltime.

The next few weeks we have a number of trainings booked for CWF and Sandtray. We would again value Pr for these.


Ben and Rachel are preparing for their iGCSE exams in May. We are also looking at future possible options for them to attend a school.
